Complete your **2018** tax return and send it to us by **09/09/2020**. We will adjust the tax, penalties, and interest according to your tax return upon receipt.

You must file even if you cannot pay. If you are financially unable to pay, you may be eligible to pay through an installment agreement once you file your tax return. Go to ftb.ca.gov/Pay for a full list of payment options.
